We develop video and print materials in all official South African languages to train teachers how to teach reading for meaning in Grades R-3 in those languages. All of our materials are free to access and Creative Commons licensed.

The COO shall manage the day-to-day operations, as well as scale up the program's reach and impact. This includes managing Media Production, Learning and Teaching Materials Development, Translation, Finance, HR, and Technology.
